Latino Scholarship Fund, Inc.
Application Checklist

The Latino Scholarship Fund, Inc., was founded in 1994 by a group concerned that less than 20 percent of Danbury High School's Latino graduates were going on to higher education. That was the lowest percentage of any ethnic group within the graduating class. To date the Latino Scholarship Fund, Inc. has raised and awarded more than \$980,000 in scholarship money to more than 550 Latino high school graduates throughout the Greater Danbury area.

Application for this scholarship is open to Latino high school seniors attending high school & residing in Fairfield County Connecticut or the Town of New Milford, Connecticut. As a matter of policy, a "Latino" shall be defined as any person at least one of whose parents and/or grandparents were born in any of the recognized Spanish speaking countries.

Requirements:

1. Applicant is a senior in high school with anticipated graduation from an accredited high school.
2. Applicant shall anticipate enrollment in a U.S. college or university.
3. Applicant will be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident or approved for Deferred Action for Childhood Arrival (DACA).
4. Applicant will fill out the enclosed application form completely.
5. Applicant must include copies of the following:
 - a. IRS 1040 Forms (First 2 Pages only), for mother, father, guardian, step-mother, step-father, self, or any other person living in the household, etc.
 - b. Transcripts (unofficial copies are acceptable, **minimum GPA of 3.0**)
 - c. 2 Letters of Recommendation from non-family members (examples: Employer, Teachers, Clergy, etc.)
 - d. Essay

Applicants will be evaluated by the Selection Committee and interviews are required for selected participants.

If selected, you will receive an e-mail to move forward with an interview.

- Essay:** Please submit a 1-2 page, typed, double spaced essay describing your personal history and how your future plans will help strengthen the Latino community.
- Letters of recommendation:** Please submit two (2) separate letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation must be from non-family members (examples: Employer, Teachers, Clergy, etc.) Letters should be in a sealed/taped envelope. They can also be emailed directly to apply@latinoscholarshipfund.com.
- Most recently filed 1040 Federal Tax returns:** for all parents/legal guardians of applicant.
- Personal Information- List Relevant Experiences during Your High School Career (Grades 9-12)**
 1. List any school organization/clubs, athletic teams, societies, etc. of which you were a member and dates of involvement
 2. List any honors or awards you have received and dates which they were received
 3. List any non-school organizations or groups to which you have belonged (include volunteer and community service work) and dates of involvement
 4. List any working experience, duration of employment and average weekly hours
